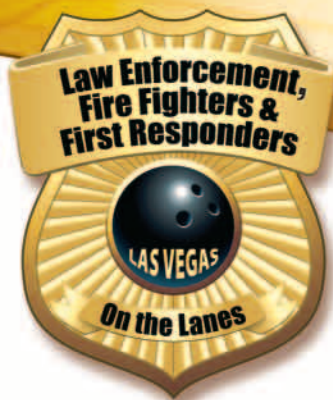

\$160 Entry Fee Per Person Includes 9 Games of Handicap Team, Doubles & Singles Events

Team Event – Teams consist of 4 players bowling 3 games each. Prizes will be paid for the highest team series combining a 1 in 8 ratio for original entries and a 1 in 12 ratio for all re-entries.

Singles Event – Players bowl 3 games. Prizes will be paid for the highest 3-game series combining a 1 in 8 ratio for original entries and a 1 in 12 ratio for all re-entries.

Doubles Event– Each player on the Doubles team bowls 3 games. Prizes will be paid for the highest Doubles team series combining a 1 in 8 ratio for original entries and a 1 in 12 ratio for all re-entries.

Optional Individual All-Events– For an optional \$20 entry fee, players add their Team, Doubles & Singles series for a 9-game total. Only scores from original events count and not scores from re-entry squads. Fee must be paid prior to bowling any of the 3 events.

General Rules:

- Each team captain must present proof of eligibility, with ID cards or letters from their agency, for at least 2 players on their team with current or retired primary occupation as a First Responder, law enforcement, fire fighters, EMT/EMS, Military Police, Shore Patrol, Border Patrol, Corrections. Also eligible are civilians who work for those agencies. Tournament manager will accept requests of occupations not listed above.
- Players without a USBC card must purchase an Associate Membership card prior to bowling.
- Handicaps are based on 90% of 220
- 220 & higher bowls scratch
- Minimum entering average for maximum handicap is 140 for men and 130 for women. Players with lower averages will get the maximum handicap
- Players without an accepted average must bowl scratch.
- Players use their handicap for each event. Example: teammates add their handicaps together for a team handicap
- Each player uses 1/3 of their handicap, dropping fractions, for sidepots and brackets
- **Accepted Averages** – Players use their highest USBC winter average, of at least 21 games from to 2009-10 or 2010-11. Players may request to use a summer average if no winter average. Youth averages cannot be used. USBC Rules 319C & 319D apply. Players may request to use their composite average from those years.

Special Prizes!

- **Senior Teams - all 4 players aged 50 & Over**
- **Mixed Teams - must include 2 or 3 females**
- **Highest Scratch Scores in Team, Singles, Doubles & All Events**

Players in line to win a prize from the main purse and also a **Special Prize** will only receive one, whichever is the largest prize.

Re-Entry Squads

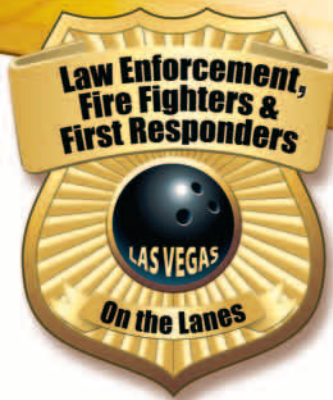
- Re-enter Singles for \$25, cash twice but only once for a prize of \$300 or higher.

Prizes Will Be Paid Onsite

After competition is completed for an event, including re-entry squads, prize lists will be posted and prize checks will be issued to each individual player providing average and eligibility verification is satisfied.

Optional Sidepots & Brackets

\$5 Sidepots – pays prizes for highest handicap games in each event.

\$5 Brackets – 8 bowler handicap Brackets pays 2 prizes in each bracket during each event.

Team Rules

- Each team consists of at least 2 that are eligible and a maximum of 2 guests.
- All players bowling in a re-entry squad must be on an original team roster.
- Only 1 PBA member or 1 High Roller \$10,000 Champ per team, and must bowl scratch.
- It is the Team Captain's responsibility to find substitutes.

Playing Rules – Rules of the Law Enforcement & Fire Fighters On The Lanes stated herein, and those of the USBC will govern all participants. The High Roller (HR) manager will have the right to resolve all questions and disputes. All decisions shall be final and binding.

General – Players can only be on one original team but may form new teams for re-entry squads with other players who also bowled on an original team. Additional squad times may be added to accommodate teams.

Team Events – HR manager must approve any roster changes prior to bowling.

Prize Money – Each player's original entry is \$168 if paid by credit card but discounted to \$160 for approved check or cash. After 15% deducted for tournament expenses and lineage, prize money is returned 100%.

Prizes – includes cash and merchandise. Prize checks will be distributed at Sam's Town. Verified unclaimed prize checks will be mailed within 5 days of tournament end. Unclaimed merchandise will not be shipped.

Bowling Balls – Only balls approved by USBC may be used.

Tournament Conduct – The HR manager shall have the right to reassign participants, if for any reason, the event cannot be completed on all or some of the lanes at Sam's Town, or on the dates drawn in any round. If by fire, war, weather conditions, gas shortage, water damage, labor unrest, terrorism acts or threats, mechanical malfunctions, acts of God, etc., it becomes impossible to conduct the HR and/or companion events, all unused portions of entry fees shall be returned.

IRS Reporting – It is the tournament's legal obligation to report an individual's earnings (not profit) of \$600 and over, including Brackets and Sidepots. 1099 forms will be issued to those players along with an accounting of their tournament expenses.

Refunds – All entry fees can be refunded 100% with notice to the HR manager of at least 24 hours before bowling starts. Hotel fees can be refunded with 48 hours notice of scheduled check-in date. Once competition begins, refunds are discretion of the HR manager. Once a player has competed in any event, including Sweepers, they may not receive a refund for Team, Singles or Doubles or portions but may be refunded future Sweepers and re-entries.



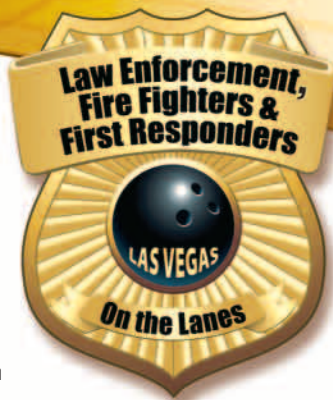
